DISMANTLING INFORMATION

HELP US OFFER YOU AN IMPECCABLE SERVICE FOR YOUR DISMANTLEMENT!

Out of respect for the visitors on the site, **you're not allowed** to start dismantling your booth **before the official closing time on Thursday, August 29 at 4 p.m.**



SCHEDULE

THURSDAY: 6 to 8 pm

For everyone's security, no vehicle will be allowed to enter or leave the site **before 6 pm**

FRIDAY: 7 am to 12 pm

The forklift trucks will be available from 7 am to 12pm.



WAITING ZONE

All vehicles with a trailer or trucks **must** park in the alternative parking on Thursday morning!

FORKLIFT TRUCKS

If you need help from our forklift trucks for more than 30 minutes, we suggest you **plan to dismantle your booth on Friday.**

We will have 5 operators on-site to help you out. Reservations aren't possible. We will allocate the resources following the order of priority for the dismantlement and arrival from the waiting area.

AT THE CLOSING OF THE SITE TO VISITORS...

- Please be patient and calm to make everyone's work easier!
- Make use of the time you have to prepare your material so it's ready to be loaded when the site opens to vehicles.
- Put your material on skids to facilitate handling by the forklift (if necessary).



VALUABLES

When you start to dismantle your booth, safely store valuables that can be easily transported (ex.: computers, tablets, etc.). We're not responsible for stolen goods.



WASTE

Please make sure to gather all your material before officially leaving your site. You **must** remove all the plants and mulch from your lot. The lot must be returned to its original condition (i.e., as it was before the event).



CLEAR YOUR SPACE

If you have rented a tent, it must be **vacated by 6 p.m. on Thursday.**

All exhibitors are required to clear their spaces **by 4 pm on Friday, August 30.**
